Greatest power failure strikes nine states

November 9...Nine North-eastern states and parts of Canada descended into sudden darkness tonight during the worst power outage in the history of the United States. At 5:17 p.m., a power station near Philadelphia inexplicably failed, cutting off power to New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia, and parts of Ohio, Kentucky, and Tennessee.

Two American astronauts in space

December 15...Two American astronauts, Thomas P. Stafford and James A. McDivitt, launched the Gemini 7 mission, a major step in the development of the Apollo moon flight program. The rendezvous mission lasted 14 days, during which the two astronauts performed various experiments and observed Earth from space.

President Johnson inaugurated

January 20...Lyndon B. Johnson, 56, was inaugurated as the 36th President of the United States in Washington, D.C. He was the first President to be inaugurated in the Lincoln Memorial.

Pope Paul VI

October 4...Pope Paul VI made an unprecedented trans-Atlantic flight to New York to address the UN General Assembly. This was the first trip a reigning Pope had ever made to the Western Hemisphere. Before making his speech, the pope conferred with President Johnson at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel.

Dodgers Win The World Series

October 6-14...The National League's Los Angeles Dodgers won their 4th baseball World Series by defeating the American League's Minnesota Twins, 4 games to 3.

Bush is President

November 8...George Herbert Walker Bush was elected President of the United States today. Bush swept the south and most of the West to defeat the Democratic nominee, Massachusetts Governor Michael Dukakis, and became the 41st President.

Summer Olympics Open in South Korea

September 17...The XXIV Summer Olympic Games began in Seoul, South Korea with opening ceremonies in front of nearly 100,000 spectators at Olympic Stadium. A record number of athletes from 160 countries were scheduled to compete.

Computer networks

November 2...A major computer network in the United States was sabotaged, with the worst incident being the tampering of a "virus" in the hidden system. Viruses are small programs that can replicate themselves and spread to other computers.

Academy Awards

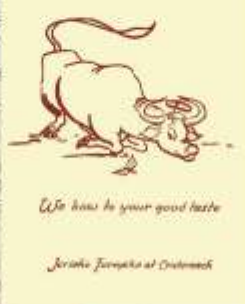
April 11...The 60th Annual Academy Awards ceremony was held at the Los Angeles Music Center. The Last Emperor dominated the awards winning 9 Oscars. Michael Douglas won the award for best actor for his performance in Wall Street and Cher was named best actress for her role in the romantic comedy Moonstruck.

The Queen Elizabeth 2, built for cruising the QE2, set out in January with 1,250 passengers for the farthest reaches of the globe.

November 29...President Ford toured the trans-Alaska pipeline today and hailed the project as a weapon in the fight to "liberate" the United States from "unreliable" foreign sources of oil.

Channel Tunnel opened

May 6...The Channel Tunnel, which runs deep under the English Channel from Folkestone, Kent, in southern England, to Calais, France, is now open. The tunnel, which costs \$15 million to build, is in fact three tunnels: Two large tunnels carry freight and passenger traffic, while a third, smaller, gallery in the middle is designed to carry service equipment and for evacuation in case of emergency.

President Nelson Mandela sworn in

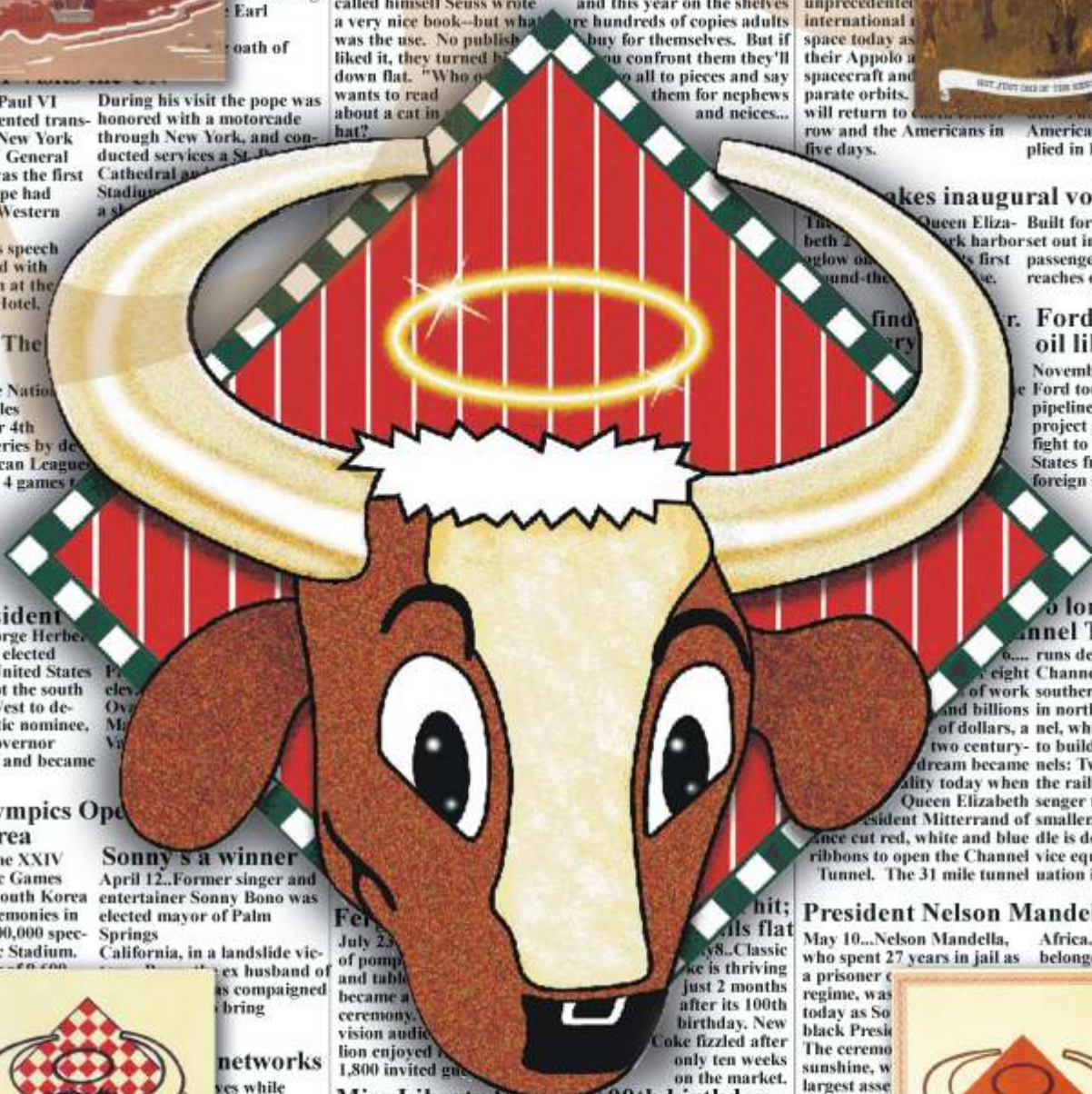

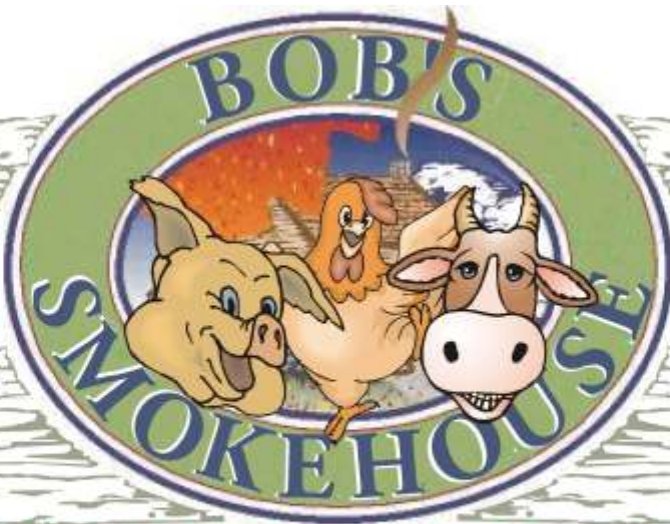
